**Under this agreement for 2018
Forest Hill State School will receive**

\$83,030*

This funding will be used to

- Improve the whole school attendance rate to 93% (from 91.2% in 2017)
- Increase the number of Year 3 & Year 5 students meeting the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in writing to 100% from 81% in Year 5 in 2017
- Increase the percentage of students meeting the regional benchmarks in reading from Prep to Year 6 to 75%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard in Mathematics and Science across Prep to Year 6 to 70%

Our initiatives include

- Employing additional staff to support students within and beyond the classroom
- Developing a case management approach to supporting students at risk
- Creating and resourcing extension programs that maximise the success of performing students
- Developing and implement the Forest Hill Writing Framework and adopting of consistent teaching protocols.
- Investing in professional capabilities of teachers in the areas of writing and Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM)
- Providing focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year level standards
