**Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...**

- ➔ Collaboratively develop future strategic and Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) documents, with measurable student outcomes, targets and milestones, to enable staff to systematically evaluate the effectiveness of AIP actions.
- ➔ Collaboratively develop a whole-school approach to pedagogy to build clarity and consistency in the use of high-impact teaching strategies.
- ➔ Develop systematic opportunities for teachers to collaboratively analyse and discuss Level of Achievement data to identify gaps in student learning and inform next steps for teaching.
- ➔ Broaden English curriculum planning processes across all learning areas to provide teachers with opportunities to deepen their understanding of the Australian Curriculum and curriculum planning expectations.
